

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Welcome to Next Big Thing Soccer (NBT Soccer). We strive to create a culture committed to empowering our players for a pathway to future success on and off the field.

As a new member of the NBT Soccer organization, I agree to adhere to the following code of conduct, and I will:

- Respect my teammates, coaches, and other club members
- Practice each session with maximum effort, focus and ability.
- Play fairly, do my best, work hard, and respect the rules of the game
- Advise the coach if I am unavailable to play or participate in club activities
- Speak directly to the coach if I have questions or concerns about training or games
- Be responsible for my own uniform, ball, gear, shin pads, water
- Refrain from using foul, abusive, racial, discriminatory language or bullying behavior

PROBLEM RESOLUTION: All parents and players should feel free to communicate with the coach but should do so only at the appropriate time and in the proper place. We encourage players to speak for themselves directly with their coach. If a problem arises that a player and/or parent feel must be resolved, the Club follows “The 24-Hour Rule”: Give one full day before initiating communications with NBT Staff, excluding emergencies that require immediate action.

I understand the consequences if I fail to stand by the commitments and expectations noted above can result in any or all the following: disciplinary action by NBT Soccer which may result in the temporary or permanent suspension of my attendance at NBT Soccer events.
